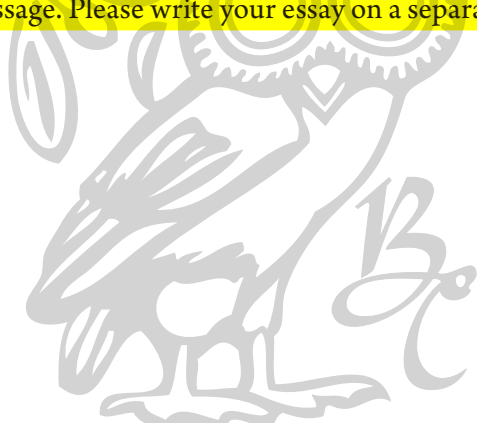
Indicate which words are correlatives used in pairs or alone and translate the complete sentence.
